By virtue of their baptismal call, Catholics are responsible for the spiritual and physical growth of the parish through witness and faithful service. Attendance at Mass is an important sign of our common faith and our support for each other in the faith community. Parents of school-age children must recognize that they are the primary educators of their children in the practice of the faith. They must fulfill the obligation to provide for the continuing religious education of their children.

Due to the size of membership, the most reliable and accurate way to determine mass attendance is through the envelope system. The pastor strongly encourages you to place an envelope, regardless of the contents, into the collection basket each week.

All members of the parish are strongly encouraged to be active in some aspect of parish life. The extent of this participation is left up to each individual's personal choice, schedule, individual talents, and life status. Participation in any of the ministries is open to everyone with the exception of Lector and Eucharist Minister, in which case you must be free to receive the Eucharist by the norms of Church law – for example, marriage outside of the Church would preclude this possibility.
