



What is Scrip?

Scrip is a term that means “substitute money”. When you purchase scrip, you’re purchasing negotiable gift certificates and prepaid cards that are used just like cash. There are NO extra, hidden fees. Just pay for the face value of the gift card or certificate for each retailer you shop, and use them just like cash. You can use scrip to purchase everyday expenses like food, clothing, and other essentials, and with every purchase, you earn revenue for Queen of All Saints.

How Does Scrip Generate Revenue?

Whenever you purchase Scrip Gift Cards, Queen of All Saints Church or School receives cash back in the amount of 1% to 25%. Remember this at no extra cost to you! To order scrip, simply complete the included order form. Scrip can be purchased with cash, money order, or check and in the future by credit or debit card.

When Can You Buy Scrip?

Scrip is sold after all the weekend masses. When school is in session scrip is sold M-W-F, 7:45 a.m. – 9:30 a.m. and T & Th 7:45 a.m. – 8:30 a.m. at the school. Send your order and payment with a student or call your order to 872-4420 Ext. 202 and pick up your order in the school office. You can even fax your order to 872-1943.

Scrip is “shopping cart fundraising”

Scrip is a popular fundraiser because families don’t have to sell anything. Queen of All Saints members produce revenue by making regular household purchases they would make anyway. Groceries, clothing, toys, gifts, even gasoline can be purchased with scrip.
